City tour of Vienna - Guided Tour of Palais Liechtenstein - Tour of Musikverein

Enjoy a spectacular day sightseeing in Vienna!

You will begin the day with an exclusive 90-minute guided tour of the Liechtenstein City Palace, owned by the Princely House of Liechtenstein, one of Europe's oldest noble families. The Liechtenstein City Palace was first purchased by Prince Johann Adam Andreas I von Liechtenstein at the end of the 17th century and transformed into the city's foremost example of High Baroque architecture. Another rarity found on the City Palace walls are a selection of masterpieces from the private art collection of the Prince von Liechtenstein.



Your tour guide will then take you on a walking tour through the Vienna City Center to view such historical landmarks including the Burgtheater, City Hall Parliament, Spanish Riding School the Hofburg and more.



Spanish Riding School

The **Hofburg** is the former principal imperial palace of the Habsburg dynasty. It was built in the 13th century and expanded several times afterwards. It also served as the imperial winter residence, as [Schönbrunn Palace](#) was the summer residence. Since 1946, it is the official residence and workplace of the president of Austria.

We will stop for lunch and then make our way to the Musikverein for a guided tour through this beautiful performance hall, home to the Vienna Philharmonic. The Musikverein is also where the famous New Year's Eve concert takes place.

Following the tour, we will reboard the bus for our return to Eisenstadt.
