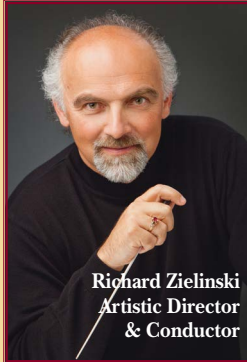

If you are looking for a rewarding music experience in a culturally rich setting, join us for 10 days in Eisenstadt, Austria – the city of Joseph Haydn! Unquestionably one of the most exciting features of the festival is rehearsing and performing in amazing and historically significant venues like the Esterházy Palace, the Bergkirche, and St. Stephen's Cathedral in Vienna--which helps bring classical music alive for today's musician. We will work hard but you will also have time to enjoy exploring Eisenstadt, going to Vienna, optional daytrips, music concerts, and more. I'm confident you will find this a life-changing experience.

Come join us!

You will fly to Vienna's International Airport for arrival on Sunday, August 6th. Festival staff will meet you at the airport on that day and bring you to Eisenstadt on festival provided buses.

FESTIVAL INCLUDES:

- Housing for 10 days with daily breakfasts
- Bus transportation to and from the Vienna Airport on Aug. 6th and Aug. 16th
- Tours of the Esterházy Palace and Vienna Opera House
- City of Eisenstadt mayor's reception
- Daytrip to Vienna to perform High Mass at St. Stephen's Cathedral
- Visit Zentralfriedhof Cemetery outside Vienna to the burial sites of Beethoven, Brahms, Strauss and others
- Enjoy an Austrian heuriger
- View original Haydn manuscripts from Esterházy archives
- Admission to all festival music concerts and lectures.
- Additional activities for OBSERVERS include guided tours of the Bergkirche where Joseph Haydn is buried, Haydn's house in Eisenstadt, wine museum, and more.



PERFORMANCE REPERTOIRE FOR 2023:

- Singers and Orchestra – Joseph Haydn: Lord Nelson Mass; Te Deum
- Orchestra only – Haydn: Trumpet Concerto; Sinfonia Concertante

Singers are required to bring the correct choral edition to the festival for the Lord Nelson Mass (Bärenreiter edition, BA 4660-90) and Te Deum (Robbins Landon edition, 5023 0310)
