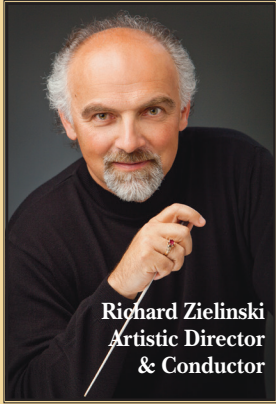

If you are looking for a rewarding music experience in a culturally rich setting, join us for 10 days in Eisenstadt, Austria – the city of Joseph Haydn! Unquestionably one of the most exciting features of the festival is rehearsing and performing in amazing and historically significant venues like the Esterházy Palace, the Bergkirche, and St. Stephen's Cathedral in Vienna—which helps bring classical music alive for today's musician. We will work hard but you will also have time to enjoy exploring Eisenstadt, going to Vienna, optional daytrips, chamber music concerts, lectures, and more. I'm confident you will find this a life-changing experience. Come join us!

You will fly to Vienna's International Airport for arrival on Saturday, August 6th. Festival staff will meet you at the airport on that day and bring you to Eisenstadt on festival provided buses.

FESTIVAL INCLUDES:

- Housing for 10 days with daily breakfasts
- Bus transportation to and from the Vienna Airport on Aug. 6th and Aug. 16th
- Tours of the Esterházy Palace and Vienna Opera House
- Festival Opening reception and City of Eisenstadt mayor's reception
- Daytrip to Vienna to perform High Mass at St. Stephen's Cathedral
- Visit Zentralfriedhof Cemetery outside Vienna to the burial sites of Beethoven, Brahms, Schubert, Strauss and others
- Enjoy an Austrian heuriger
- View original Haydn manuscripts from the Esterházy archives
- Admission to all festival chamber music concerts, recitals, and lectures
- Additional activities for OBSERVERS include guided tours of the Bergkirche where Joseph Haydn is buried, Haydn's house in Eisenstadt, Judengasse with Jewish museum, wine tasting seminar, and more
